CALL FOR PAPERS

The full papers which should include an introduction and a list of references as per Harvard referencing system shall be of no more than eight (08) A4 size pages excluding the cover sheet. The details of the author shall not be included within the paper and a separate cover sheet with author details and sub theme shall be submitted. Final papers will be double-blind reviewed by two members of the review panel. The papers which should be submitted via email to univotecsymposium2019@gmail.com will be acknowledged. The author/s of the papers that have been selected will be informed of the comments made by the reviewers. Guidelines for the preparation of the full papers are annexed.

Submitted articles must not have been previously published, nor should they be submitted for consideration for publication elsewhere, while under review for this symposium.

The Editorial Board will conduct an initial review of submitted papers. Those judged suitable for publication will be sent to at least two independent referees for double blind peer review, after which submissions may be recommended for revisions and further review, acceptance or rejection.
